## Wordpress / Global Variables

Name	Default Value	Declared in	Purpose
<b>WP_USE_THEMES</b>	true	index.php	?????
<b>WP_INSTALLING</b>	true	wp-admin/setup-config.php wp-admin/install.php	Set to true during installation process. False otherwise.
<b>DB_NAME</b>	\$dbname	wp-admin/setup-config.php	Used to hold the name of the WordPress database.
<b>DB_USER</b>	\$uname	wp-admin/setup-config.php	Used to hold the username of the WordPress database user.
<b>DB_PASSWORD</b>	\$passwd	wp-admin/setup-config.php	Used to hold the password of the WordPress database user.
<b>DB_HOST</b>	\$dbhost	wp-config.php wp-config-sample.php wp-admin/setup-config.php	Used to hold the hostname of the WordPress database.
<b>WPLANG</b>		wp-config.php wp-config-sample.php	Used to set the language to be used by WordPress.
<b>ABSPATH</b>	dirname(__FILE__).'/'	wp-config.php wp-config-sample.php	Used to hold the path to the WordPress folder/directory.

Name	Default Value	Declared in	Purpose
<b>\$wp_did_header</b>	false	wp-blog-header.php	Gets set to true after checking for existence of the wp-config.php file.
<b>\$configFile</b>	file('../wp-config-sample.php')	wp-admin/setup-config.php	Gets set to the default WordPress sample configuration file.
<b>\$step</b>	0	wp-admin/setup-config.php	Used to store the number of the current step of the "Setup Configuration File" process.
<b>\$table_prefix</b>	'wp_'	wp-config.php wp-config-sample.php	Used to store the prefix to be used in the name of WordPress database tables.
